What Happened	<p style="text-align: center;">White van with Age Concern written on the side</p> <p>A distraction offence at the above location, due to the victim suffering from Alzheimer's some of the details are a little confused, however she did repeatedly state that two males kept trying to gain access to her property to carry out work.</p> <p>Two neighbours stated they had seen a white van parked outside the address with Age Concern written on the side. Age Concern Tameside confirmed no vans were operating in the Ashton area on that day. Tameside Age Concern vans do not have the logo on the side.</p>
