## Protecting Vulnerable People

Our Priority Areas for Action are:

- Children and Young People Missing from Home or Care
- Domestic Violence and Abuse
- Child Sexual Exploitation
- Hate Crime
- Complex Safeguarding (including modern slavery, human trafficking, female genital mutilation and honour-based violence)

## Managing Delivery

For each of the Partnership's Priority Themes, priority areas for action and high level action plans are identified and refreshed annually. To ensure accountability for delivery, each Priority Theme has a Theme Lead Officer who is responsible for identifying the most effective strategies and governance arrangements for delivering these priorities alongside partners.

## Communities and Places

Our Plan is underpinned by key principles about the way we work with communities and join up services as locally as possible. We are committed to working together across communities and organisations to make Stockport a safer place to live, work and visit. We will:

- Build on the strengths that exist within our communities and work with them in a way that enables them to grow as active, cohesive and resilient communities
- Continue to learn from and further develop approaches to joining up services at a local level
- Work towards an inclusive vision, ensuring that interventions addressing community safety issues are targeted to our most vulnerable locations.
